Dear UE Local 1043 (SGWU):

During contract negotiations, the Union raised the topic of housing rates for graduate students living on campus. Housing is understandably a significant portion of someone's monthly expenses and future housing costs are typically not known.

The University typically announces graduate housing rates in the spring for the following University calendar year (September 1 to August 31). However, the University has decided to publish graduate housing rates for 2025-26 and 2026-27 in advance to provide graduate students with more certainty for planning purposes. The University has committed to these published rates for graduate student housing, and they will not change.
